### 6. Neighbourhood Policing Model Project

The Barrie Police Service identified implementing a neighbourhood policing model as one of the 2017-2019 strategic priorities. This was identified after completing internal and external engagement exercises asking for input from the community. A Project Team was formed which includes Deputy Chief Ken Weatherill as the Project Sponsor, Inspector Rob Burke as the Project Manager and a Team of 14 Sworn and Civilian members. This Project Team has had meetings and completed tasks making the deployment of the Neighbourhood Policing possible in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2019.

The Neighbourhood Patrol Model will have officers assigned to specific neighbourhoods for a period of 18-24 months. This will assist officers with building relationships with residents and business owners and the community in their assigned patrol area. A community event will be held as a public launch in Spring 2020 in our new Barrie Simcoe Emergency Service Campus.

It was requested that the Neighbourhood Policing Model be added to the agenda for the October 17, 2019 meeting for further discussion.

18. Records Checks for Volunteers

In August 2019, a review was conducted on what police services across Ontario are charging for records checks. The review determined that out of 47 police services only 7 offered free volunteer checks. Currently, The Barrie Police Services charges \$12 for online volunteer checks and it is free of charge if you attend the station. The recommendation is to implement a \$12 in-person fee commencing in January 2020 to align the Barrie Police Service with other services. This will be brought back to the next meeting on October 17, 2019 for further discussion.
