- [Procedure #4](#) – Problem Oriented Policing & Crime Prevention

1.0 Preamble

1.1 WHEREAS subsection 31(1) of the ***Police Services Act*** provides that a Board is responsible for the provision of Police Services and for Law Enforcement and Crime Prevention in the Municipality and shall:

- 1.1.1 Generally determine after consultation with the Chief of Police, objectives and priorities with respect to the Police Service in the Municipality;
- 1.1.2 Establish priorities for the effective management of the Police Service, and
- 1.1.3 Direct the Chief of Police and monitor their performance.

1.2 AND whereas ***O. Reg. 3/99*** prescribes standards for adequacy and effectiveness of Police Services.

2.0 Definitions

2.1 **Board** – shall mean the Barrie Police Services Board.

2.2 **BPS** – the acronym for the Barrie Police Service.

2.3 **Chief** – shall mean the Chief of Police.

3.0 Policy

- 3.1 It is the policy of the Board with respect to Problem-Oriented Policing that the Chief will:
- 3.1.1 Require appropriate Supervisors and frontline Members to work, where possible, with Municipalities, School Boards, Businesses, Community Organizations and Members of the Public to address:
 - 3.1.1.1 Crime.
 - 3.1.1.2 Public Disorder, and
 - 3.1.1.3 Road Safety.
 - 3.1.2 Require appropriate Supervisors and Frontline Members to promote and implement Problem-Oriented Policing initiatives to respond to:
 - 3.1.2.1 Identified Crime.
 - 3.1.2.2 Community Safety.
 - 3.1.2.3 Public Disorder, and
 - 3.1.2.4 Road Safety Problems, including:
 - 3.1.2.4.1 Repeat calls for service, and
 - 3.1.2.4.2 Repeat victimization.
 - 3.1.3 Ensure that Supervisors and frontline Members are provided with information and resource material on Problem-Oriented Policing.
 - 3.1.4 Promote the use of Directed Patrol, Targeted Enforcement and other initiatives to respond to high crime or high occurrence places/areas and serial occurrences.
 - 3.1.5 Develop procedures to support the promotion and implementation of Problem-Oriented Policing, and
 - 3.1.6 Provide information in the Annual Report on the steps taken by BPS to promote, implement and evaluation Problem-Oriented Policing initiatives.
