1.0 Preamble

1.1 WHEREAS subsection 31(1) of the ***Police Services Act*** provides that a Board is responsible for the provision of Police Services and for Law Enforcement and Crime Prevention in the Municipality and shall:

- 1.1.1 Generally determine after consultation with the Chief of Police, objectives and priorities with respect to the Police Service in the Municipality;
- 1.1.2 Establish priorities for the effective management of the Police Service, and
- 1.1.3 Direct the Chief of Police and monitor their performance.

1.2 AND whereas ***O. Reg. 3/99*** prescribes standards for adequacy and effectiveness of Police Services.

2.0 Definitions

2.1 **Board** – shall mean the Barrie Police Services Board.

2.2 **BPS** – the acronym for the Barrie Police Service.

2.3 **Chief** – shall mean the Chief of Police.

3.0 Policy

3.1 It is the policy of the Board with respect to Crime, Call and Public Disorder Analysis, that the Chief will:

- 3.1.1 Ensure that the BPS conducts Crime, Call and Public Disorder Analysis.

- 3.1.2 Establish systems and procedures for the collection, collation, analysis and dissemination of crime, call and public disorder data.
- 3.1.3 Ensure that BPS Members and persons who assist to perform Crime, Call and Public Disorder Analysis have the knowledge, skills and abilities to perform the functions and have the necessary equipment.
- 3.1.4 Promote the use of crime analysis by Supervisors to identify areas or issues requiring:
 - 3.1.4.1 Directed Patrol.
 - 3.1.4.2 Targeted Enforcement, and
 - 3.1.4.3 Problem-Oriented or Community Based Crime Prevention Initiatives.
- 3.1.5 Report back to the Board on the criteria and process to be used for sharing relevant Crime, Call and Public Disorder Analysis with:
 - 3.1.5.1 Municipal Council and Officials.
 - 3.1.5.2 School Boards.
 - 3.1.5.3 Community organizations and groups.
 - 3.1.5.4 Businesses, and
 - 3.1.5.5 Members of the public.
- 3.1.6 Provide information in the Annual Report on crime, calls for service and public disorder patterns, trends and forecasts based on Crime, Call and Public Disorder Analysis.
