1.0 Preamble

1.1 WHEREAS subsection 31(1) of the ***Police Services Act*** provides that a Board is responsible for the provision of Police Services and for Law Enforcement and Crime Prevention in the Municipality and shall:

- 1.1.1 Generally determine after consultation with the Chief of Police, objectives and priorities with respect to the Police Service in the Municipality;
- 1.1.2 Establish priorities for the effective management of the Police Service, and
- 1.1.3 Direct the Chief of Police and monitor their performance.

1.2 AND whereas ***O. Reg. 3/99*** prescribes standards for adequacy and effectiveness of Police Services.

2.0 Definitions

2.1 **Board** – shall mean the Barrie Police Services Board.

2.2 **BPS** – the acronym for the Barrie Police Service.

2.3 **Chief** – shall mean the Chief of Police.

3.0 Policy

3.1 It is the policy of the Board with respect to Criminal Intelligence, that the Chief will:

- 3.1.1 Ensure that criminal intelligence is provided by BPS Members.

- 3.1.2 Establish priorities and procedures for Criminal Intelligence, including Strategic and Tactical Intelligence.
- 3.1.3 Promote the use of Criminal Intelligence Analysis by Supervisors to identify areas or issues requiring:
 - 3.1.3.1 Directed Patrol.
 - 3.1.3.2 Targeted Enforcement, and
 - 3.1.3.3 Problem-Oriented Policing Initiatives or Community-Based Crime Prevention Initiatives.
- 3.1.4 Ensure that BPS Members who perform the Criminal Intelligence function, have the knowledge, skills and abilities to perform these duties and the necessary tools and equipment.
