1.1	WHEREAS subsection 31(1) of the <i>Police Services Act</i> provides that a Board is responsible for the provision of Police Services and for Law Enforcement and Crime Prevention in the Municipality and shall:			
	1.1.1 Generally determine after consultation with the Chief of Police, objectives and priorities with respect to the Police Service in the Municipality;			
	1.1.2 Establish priorities for the effective management of the Police Service, and			
	1.1.3 Direct the Chief of Police and monitor their performance.			
1.2	AND whereas <b>O. Reg. 3/99</b> prescribes standards for adequacy and effectiveness of Police Services.			
2.0	<u>Definitions</u>			
2.1	Board – shall mean the Barrie Police Services Board.			
2.2	BPS – the acronym for the Barrie Police Service.			

Chief - shall mean the Chief of Police.

3.0 Policy
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- 3.1 It is the policy of the Board with respect to Vehicle Thefts, that the Chief will:
  - 3.1.1 Develop and maintain procedures that require that investigations be undertaken in accordance with the BPS Criminal Investigation Management Plan, and
  - 3.1.2 Ensure the timely notifications of registered owners of the recovery of Stolen Vehicles, except where ongoing criminal investigations may be compromised.
