1.0 Preamble

1.1 WHEREAS subsection 31(1) of the ***Police Services Act*** provides that a Board is responsible for the provision of Police Services and for Law Enforcement and Crime Prevention in the Municipality and shall:

- 1.1.1 Generally determine after consultation with the Chief of Police, objectives and priorities with respect to the Police Service in the Municipality;
- 1.1.2 Establish priorities for the effective management of the Police Service, and
- 1.1.3 Direct the Chief of Police and monitor their performance.

1.2 AND whereas ***O. Reg. 3/99*** prescribes standards for adequacy and effectiveness of Police Services.

2.0 Definitions

2.1 **Board** – shall mean the Barrie Police Services Board.

2.2 **BPS** – the acronym for the Barrie Police Service.

2.3 **Chief** – shall mean the Chief of Police.

3.0 Policy

- 3.1 It is the policy of the Board with respect to the Ontario Sex Offender Registry, that the Chief will:
- 3.1.1 Designate and maintain a registration site(s).
 - 3.1.2 Establish procedures and processes consistent with the requirements of ***Christopher's Law (Sex Offender Registry), 2000.***
 - 3.1.3 Establish procedures and processes consistent with the requirements legislated by the Federal ***Sex Offender Information Registration Act.***
 - 3.1.4 Ensure that appropriate Members receive training on the Ontario Sex Offender Registry, consistent with the role and responsibilities assigned to them, and
 - 3.1.5 Ensure that appropriate Members receive training on both the Provincial and Federal Sex Offender legislative requirements.
