1.0 Preamble

1.1 WHEREAS subsection 31(1) of the ***Police Services Act*** provides that a Board is responsible for the provision of Police Services and for Law Enforcement and Crime Prevention in the Municipality and shall:

- 1.1.1 Generally determine after consultation with the Chief of Police, objectives and priorities with respect to the Police Service in the Municipality;
- 1.1.2 Establish priorities for the effective management of the Police Service, and
- 1.1.3 Direct the Chief of Police and monitor their performance.

1.2 AND whereas ***O. Reg. 3/99*** prescribes standards for adequacy and effectiveness of Police Services.

2.0 Definitions

2.1 **Board** – shall mean the Barrie Police Services Board.

2.2 **BPS** – the acronym for the Barrie Police Service.

2.3 **Chief** – shall mean the Chief of Police.

3.0 Policy

3.1 It is the policy of the Board with respect to High Risk Individuals, that the Chief will:

3.1.1 Work in partnership, where possible, with the local Crown, appropriate Community Members and Agencies, including Health Care providers, Government Agencies, Municipal Officials, other Criminal Justice Agencies, including Law Enforcement Agencies, as well as Victim Services to ensure a coordinated and effective strategy in response to High Risk Individuals that address:

3.1.2 Bail opposition consistent with the Ministry's guideline on Bail and Violent Crime.

3.1.3 Dangerous Offender and Long Term Offender applications.

3.1.4 High Risk Offender National Flagging System and requirements of CPIC.

3.1.5 Information sharing.

3.1.6 Case management planning.

3.1.7 Judicial Restraint Orders.

3.1.8 Victim Assistance, and

3.1.9 Disclosure of information, including community notification safety planning.

3.2 Ensure that the BPS Skills Development and Learning Plan addresses the training and sharing of information with Officers, Communication Operators/Dispatchers and Supervisors on the police response to High Risk Individuals.
