



**REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS
FOR THE RIGHT TO TOW VEHICLES FROM CITY STREETS**

The Barrie Police Services Board is requesting proposals for the right to tow disabled and/or impounded vehicles from City streets:

Part A – Vehicles Up to 6,500 kg

Part B – Vehicles Over 6,500 kg (Heavy Towing & Recovery)

Applicants may bid for either Part “A” or Part “B” or both. Proposal packages can be obtained at the Barrie Police Service Headquarters at 110 Fairview Road, Barrie, Ontario commencing at **9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 1st, 2023.**

Completed packages will be received by the undersigned on behalf of the Barrie Police Services Board until **3:00 pm, Wednesday November 15th, 2023.**

This proposal is for services for the period of two (2) years, commencing 12:00 a.m. January 1st, 2024, and terminating 11:59 pm December 31st, 2025, with an option for a third year.

The successful bidder must comply with certain mandatory requirements which are listed within the Request for Proposal packages. Lowest or any proposal not necessarily accepted.
